At Happisburgh Primary School, we believe that the wearing of school uniform creates a sense of identity and also gives pupils a greater sense of equality. All pupils are expected to wear school uniform and to present themselves well.

Our school uniform consists of:

- Blue jumper, fleece or cardigan (no hoodies), with or without school logo
- White or light blue polo shirt
- Grey or black skirt, shorts, dress or trousers
- Plain white, black or grey socks or tights
- Black school shoes (no trainers)

In warmer weather, children may wear blue gingham summer dresses

PE kit

For PE children should wear:

- Navy or black shorts
- White or light blue T- shirt
- Navy or black tracksuit
- Plimsolls or trainers

All children will also need a warm, waterproof coat and a pair of outdoor trainers or wellies as the children are outside all year round.

Fashion clothing, jewellery or footwear is not appropriate and should not be worn. Make up, including nail varnish, should not be worn. It is important that the children wear sensible, flat shoes for safety in school and on play equipment such as the trim trail.
